

Installing WinPlot on Ubuntu 9.04

- 1) Download the latest version of WinPlot (wp32z.exe from <http://math.exeter.edu/rparris/winplot.html>) to your Desktop
- 2) Install Wine (use the Add/Remove feature in Ubuntu if desired), or start a terminal and type "sudo apt-get install wine"
- 3) Download and run winetricks (<http://wiki.winehq.org/winetricks>) to your Desktop
- 4) Start a Terminal session and run "sudo ~/Desktop/winetricks corefonts"
- 5) Copy the symbol.ttf font (available if you search for it online) into your "c:\windows\fonts" directory in Wine (you can access this directory easily by using the "Browse C: drive" command in the Wine menu under Applications).
- 6) Right-click on wp32z.exe (downloaded from the WinPlot website), and select Extract Here.
- 7) Right-click on WinPlot.exe and select "Open with Wine Program Loader"

Note: you can move WinPlot.exe wherever you like after you get to this stage. I keep my copy in the directory I use for school work. Always start it by right-clicking on WinPlot.exe and selecting "Open with Wine Program Loader".
